

## **Quick Facts about the Patent and Know-How License Agreement**

- RainLine is granting a non-exclusive license to use The RainLine System<sup>SM</sup> for Licensed Projects.
- This broad agreement applies only to those projects for which you obtain a RainLine Project Code Number. No project will be considered a licensed project until it has been assigned a Project Code. These numbers can be obtained from The RainLine Corporation by completing the RainLine Project Code Number Request Form.
- RainLine will deliver the equipment which is part of The RainLine System and which is needed to practice the methods claimed in RainLine's patents to you. We will also supply a technician to help install the equipment on your self-propelled thermoplastic striping machine and help train your personnel in the proper use of The RainLine System.
- You are agreeing to use only materials that are compatible with The RainLine System and meeting the RainLine Standard Specifications. You also agree to comply with all specifications of the Department of Transportation and The RainLine Corporation.
- You will be able to purchase thermoplastic material for use with THE RAINLINE SYSTEM<sup>SM</sup> from the material manufacturer of your choice.
- If you choose to buy your material from a manufacturer who has an agreement to collect the licensing fee on behalf of The RainLine Corporation and remit it to The RainLine Corporation, you will pay by the ton in one check at the same time you pay for your material.
- If you choose to buy your thermoplastic material from a manufacturer who has no such agreement, the entire royalty fee due based on the estimated amount of material that you will need to complete the Licensed Project (as referenced in the attached RainLine standard material usage requirements) is due directly to The RainLine Corporation PRIOR TO STARTING THE LICENSED PROJECT. Upon completion of the Licensed Project an adjustment will be made if more or less tons of thermoplastic material was used.

## **Important Dates**

- **15 Days after signing job contract:** Send RainLine Project Code Number Request Form to The RainLine Corporation.
- **2 Days after submitting purchase order for thermoplastic material for use with The RainLine System:** Send a copy of that purchase order to The RainLine Corporation.
- **15 Days after completion of project:** Send a tally of the actual quantity of thermoplastic material used in completing the Licensed Project, and the actual footage of traffic stripe placed to The RainLine Corporation.

## **Technical Information**

- A standard RainLine kit is composed of a special double curtain coater glass bead gun assembly, RainLine profiling die (wheel), water spray nozzle, hitch assembly for attaching to your truck, etc. This equipment will always remain the property of The RainLine Corporation. The RainLine Corporation reserves the right to charge a deposit for specialty kits or in any special circumstances.
- You will need to have a small pressure tank (approximately 2 gallons or larger capacity) on your machine for water.
